



The [Institut français](#) and its European partners, the [Goethe-Institut](#) (in Belgium) and [Izolyatsia](#) (in Ukraine), are launching the 2nd edition of the [i-Portunus](#) pilot project to support mobility of artists' and professionals in the cultural and creative sectors in Europe. i-Portunus is a project co-financed by the European Union's Creative Europe program. This project should allow about 200 artists' and professionals' mobilities to be supported for periods of 7 to 60 days, in all States eligible for Creative Europe.

DISCIPLINES COVERED

Between December 2020 and February 2021, three cycles of call for applications will be open for artists' and professionals in the cultural and creative sectors, in the sectors of music, books (translation), architecture and heritage.

MOBILITY LENGTH OF TIME

The mobility length will be from 7 to 60 days. Financial support will be as a set amount for international transport and a per diem amount provided according to the destination country.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives sought by projects include short term mobilities (non-exhaustive list, for information purposes):

- Develop collaborations
- Enhance practice
- Produce / co-produce
- Find new professional opportunities
- Reach new publics

CALLS SCHEDULE

Music (1st session) – currently open

- Call for applications: 9 December 2020 to 28 February 2021
- Communication of results: 2 April 2021
- Mobility periods: between 2 June and 30 November 2021

Literary translation – currently open

- Call for applications: 9 December 2020 to 28 February 2021
- Communication of results: 2 April 2021
- Mobility periods: between 2 June and 30 November 2021

Architecture – currently open

- Call for applications: 15 January to 14 March 2021
- Communication of results: 16 April 2021
- Mobility periods: between 16 June and 30 November 2021

Heritage – to be announced

- Call for applications: 15 February to 15 April 2021
- Communication of results: 21 May 2021
- Mobility periods: between 15 July and 30 November 2021

Music (2nd session) – to be announced

- Call for applications: 15 February to 15 April 2021
- Communication of results: 21 May 2021
- Mobility periods: between 15 July and 30 November 2021

Each call for applications will be open for two months. Each application will be evaluated by two experts. The results will be notified one month after the application deadline and mobilities will be possible until November 2021, conditions permitting.

WORKSHOPS

In collaboration with [Transartists](#), several online workshops will be offered (the first ones will take place on February 3 and 17, 2021) to present the i-Portunus program and advise artists on "how to apply".

As well as their overseas countries and territories: Greenland, New Caledonia and dependent territories, French Polynesia, French Southern and Antarctic Lands, Wallis and Futuna islands, Saint Pierre et Miquelon, Saint-Barthelemy, Aruba, Netherlands Antilles (Bonaire, Curaçao, Sabo, Saint Eustatius, Saint Maarten), Anguilla, Cayman Islands, Falkland Islands, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands), Montserrat, Pitcairn, Saint-Helena and its dependent territories, British Antarctic Territory, British Indian Ocean Territory, Turks and Caicos Islands, British Virgin Islands, Bermuda.
